1. - CLUB RULES & CONSTITUTION

2. – MEMBERSHIP

The CLUB membership period runs annually from the 1st August to July 31st

Payment should be made prior to the 30th of September each year. This is to ensure relevant resources and insurance are in place for the member to take part in club activities. Any membership not paid for after this date will result in the membership being placed on hold and the player will not be able to participate in any club training activities or matches until payment is received.

Payment may be split into two payments on request. Requests should be made to a CLUB team manager and passed to the CLUB Registrations Officer. Split payments must be received before the 30th of September and 31st January to avoid any membership being placed on hold as above.

The CLUB may offer a trial membership to new members; this is at the discretion of the committee and will expire automatically after 1 month should the member not proceed to full membership with payment. All members on a trial membership must register with the Club Registration Form. Managers and coaches must notify the Secretary and Child Welfare Officer of members on trial period.

Any player registered with Charlestown Youth & Ladies FC who trains or plays with/for another club/team must have this approved by the team lead coach or committee. Any player found actively involved with another club without prior consent could risk having their membership revoked. All committee members, coaches, players, supporters, and match officials are expected to follow CLUB rules and the relevant code of conduct. If you do not membership maybe revoked (in line with FA Clubs Rules and Constitution) and you may be banned from the premises.

3. TEAMWEAR –

All club teamwear must be supplied by the clubs approved supplier only. Our current teamwear supplier is Macron Cornwall. Managers and coaches should direct all new teamwear orders to Macron Cornwall or via the committee. Club players and members should use the official club shop, enquire through their team manager or coach, or by contacting Macron Cornwall directly. When a player / member leaves the club any playing / training kit the member / player has that has been supplied by the club / sponsor must be returned in full. Failure to return these items will result in the club requiring full reimbursement for the replacement of these items.
